Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 139 dated 10.8.2020 under Sections 295-A, 323, 341, 148 read with Section 149 IPC registered at Police Station Jhunir, Mansa.

This Court, on 22.09.2020, passed the following order:

“Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 139 dated 10.8.2020 under Sections 295-A, 323, 341, 148 read with Section 149 IPC registered at Police Station Jhunir, Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the only allegation against the petitioner is that he has pulled the hair of Jaswinder Singh and all the offences are bailable

except the offence Section 295-A IPC. He further submits that the occurrence took place at 6.30 P.M. whereas the complainant was admitted in the hospital at 8.35 P.M. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner is only 19 years of age and has cleared his IELTS and due to this reason, he has been involved in the present case.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Mehta, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Adjourned to 20.1.2021.

Meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance with the order dated 22.09.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Gurdarshan Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 22.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
