Prayer in this petition is for quashing of General Diary Details No.29 dated 04.05.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 295, 506 IPC at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar, which is a counter blast to FIR No.23 dated 04.05.2019 registered under Sections 353, 186, 332, 506 IPC at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that a period of 02 years has lapsed, however, the investigation of FIR No.23 dated 04.05.2019 is not yet completed and the aforesaid General Diary has been registered as a counter blast to FIR No.23 dated 04.05.2019.

Counsel for the State has raised an objection that since the case is still at the investigation stage, this petition is pre-mature.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, along with all the documents of defence and the same
