This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0183 dated 08.04.2019, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Jind City, District Jind, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of complainant-Chander Bhan, it is stated that his brother Chandi Ram Jangra died on 19.03.2017 and by impersonation, a loan of Rs.7,00,000/- was raised on the property of Parvesh, who is wife of Chandi Ram. The petitioner Surender Kumar stood as a guarantor and Krishna impersonated herself as Parvesh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is neither a beneficiary of the loan nor he had any direct role, rather he stood as a guarantor and in case any liability against the loan arises, it is for the petitioner to take over the same as per the terms and conditions

of the guarantee submitted by him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is in custody for the last about more than one month and investigation qua him is complete.

Learned State counsel submits that as per the investigation it is found that the petitioner has taken money from Krishna for raising the said loan.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate, concerned.
