The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0124 dated 19.04.2019 under Sections 498-A, 323, 506 of IPC and Section 66 of Information Technology Act, 2000 (mentioned as Section 65 in Impugned order Annexure P-4) registered at Police Station Division No. 8, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had been married to the complainant in the year 2006 and disputes arose thereafter. It is submitted that pursuant to order dated 06.06.2019, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and an attempt was also made to have the matter settled amicably through mediation which has failed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Amrit Pal Singh, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and that the matter has been investigated.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated and petitioner has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 06.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
