The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., *inter alia* seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents No.1 to 4, for conducting fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No. 107, dated 06.07.2021, lodged under Secitons 323, 354, 509, 34 of IPC, registered at P.S. Women Police Station Karnal, Haryana.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, while drawing the attention of this Court to the reply dated 10.12.2021, filed by way of affidavit of Himadree Kaushik, IPS, ASP, Indri, Karnal-1, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 (State), has submitted that during investigation two persons i.e. Paramjeet and Murti Devi, sister-in-law and mother-in-law of the complainant, were found innocent and placed in column No.2, whereas, Attar Singh, father-in-law of the complainant was challaned and is now facing trial before the trial Court. He has further submitted that charges are likely to be framed in the near future.

In the circumstances and more particular in view of the aforesaid reply filed by the State, no further order is called for and the instant petition stands disposed of accordingly.
