Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.49 dated 03.06.2020, registered under Section 21(1) of Mines & Minerals Development Act, Section 19 of Punjab Land & Preservation Act, 1900 and Sections 63 & 67 of Indian Forest Act, Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Ropar.

Vide order dated 20.08.2021, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 20.08.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Subhash Chander submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 20.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
