The petitioners, claiming themselves to be aged about 22 and 49 years respectively, have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the averments that the petitioners, being major, performed marriage on 16.09.2020 as per Hindu rites and ceremonies against the wishes of respondents No.5 to 8 and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Notice of the petition was given to respondents vide order dated 21.09.2020 whereby respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, District Gurdaspur was also directed to look into the grievances of the petitioners as set out in the petition and also expressed in the representation dated 16.09.2020 (Annexure P-5) and to take appropriate action for protection of their life and liberty as may be warranted by the circumstances.

Ms. Parvinder Kaur, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division City Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur has filed reply by way of her affidavit mentioning therein that on enquiry conducted it transpired that both the petitioners are enjoying their married life happily and they have no apprehension to their life and liberty.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that now the petitioners have no apprehension of danger from respondents No. 5 to 8 and the petition may be disposed of as having become infructuous with liberty to get the same restored in case of apprehension of any danger from respondents No. 5 to 8 in future.

Disposed of as having become infructuous with liberty as aforesaid.
