The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to transfer and issue the share certificate in the name of the petitioner which has been refused on the ground that an amount of Rs. 6,66,700/- is outstanding whereas the same has been paid vide cheque No. 198702 on 27.10.1999 and the respondent No.4 had issued the receipt also to the allottee of the plot in question, for which, representation dated 03.03.2020

(Annexure P-9) has also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner's side the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider the representation dated 03.03.2020 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
