This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 02.08.2021 to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into and decide representation dated 02.08.2021 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
