The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.44 dated 24.04.2019 registered under Sections 302/363/366-A/201/34 IPC (Sections 376(3)/376-D/201/34 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 added later on) at Police Station Khanauri, district Sangrur.

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that in the petitioner's trial the prosecution has led its entire evidence and the matter is now posted on 06.12.2021 for defence evidence, if any and final arguments.

In the light of the above statement, at the fag end of the petitioner's trial, it is considered undesirable to grant regular bail to the petitioner.
