The present appeal has been preferred under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 for enhancement of the compensation.

It transpired that learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Faridabad (for short 'the Tribunal') vide impugned award dated 20.05.2005 granted compensation of Rs.2,00,000/- along with interest @ 6% per annum from the date of filing of the claim petition till its realization. Insurer was held liable to pay the compensation to the appellant.

Now, during the pendency of the present appeal, the matter has been compromised between the parties amicably. Respondent No.4 has offered an amount of Rs.1,75,000/- over and above the amount of compensation already awarded by the Tribunal, which is acceptable to the appellant.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, this appeal is disposed off as having been finally settled with the free consent of the parties. Amount of Rs. 1,75,000/- shall be deposited with the Lok Adalat Branch of this Court within a period of 06 weeks from today failing which, the amount would carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of settlement till its realization. The terms and conditions of disbursement of the aforesaid enhanced amount of compensation will remain unaltered, as passed by learned Tribunal.
