LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in the writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release payment of Rs.3,41,666/- towards execution of the work in question alongwith interest.

Learned counsel submits that there is no dispute regarding completion of work to the satisfaction of the authorities or payment to be released. It is submitted that despite serving legal notice dated 19.07.2021 (Annexure P3) upon the respondents, no action is being taken.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts the prayer for a direction that legal notice dated 19.07.2021 (Annexure P3), be decided by the authorities in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sahil Sharma, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and does not raise any serious objection to the limited prayer addressed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, but without any expression of opinion on the merits of the matter, this petition is disposed of

with a direction to the competent authority to decide legal notice dated 19.07.2021 (Annexure P3), within a period of three months from receipt of certified copy of this order. Amount, if any, found due to the petitioner be released within six weeks thereafter. In case of an order adverse to the petitioner, same be by way of speaking order.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
