Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.47 dated 28.07.2021, registered at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda, under Sections 308, 323 and 34 IPC.

Vide order dated 23.08.2021, passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gurmit Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation. He further submits that, since, the petitioner has joined the investigation, the State did not intend to file the status report.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
