Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 to release/disburse the compensation of the structure of 4 shops duly assessed by the respondents vide award dated 13.08.2019 (Annexure P-7).

In the affidavit filed by respondent No.3 today, it has been mentioned that Basant Lal and other, co-sharers have filed objections to the share of compensation and the amount granted for structure. The dispute has been referred to the Court of the Addl.District & Sessions Judge, Narnaul along with Rs.5,67,758/- as per the provisions of Section 3H(4) of the National Highways Act, 1956.

Thus, keeping in view the above, no case is made out for issuance of any direction once there is a dispute regarding the apportionment, pending before the Reference Court. Resultantly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
