The petitioner has challenged the result (Annexure P-2) whereby respondent No. 7 has been selected by Bharat Petroleum Corporation for setting up a retail outlet. The challenge is based upon allegations that site for which he has been selected as dealer does not conform to the prescribed rules/regulations. If that is so, the petitioner must challenge the advertisement whereby the said site has been put in the public domain. The advertisement has not been challenged and, thus, challenge to the result Annexure P-2 can not be accepted.

In view of the above, the writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
