The petitioner herein seeks the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case pertaining to the FIR bearing No.57 dated 05.08.2021 registered at Police Station Patara, District Jalandhar, under Section 3(1) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Sections 341 and 506 IPC.

Ms. Samina Dhir, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has joined the proceedings, in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance.

Mr. Rahul Kumar Adia, Advocate, has also joined the proceedings on behalf of the complainant in this case and has forwarded his Power of Attorney to this Court through the '*Whatsapp Group for Video-Conferencing*' and the same is taken on the record.
