The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the petitioner benefit in term of the judgment rendered in CWP-16538-2011 decided on 06.09.2011 (Annexure P-8) and CWP-10008-2006 decided on 23.02.2010 (Annexure P-9) and to grant the petitioner benefit of past service rendered in Punjab State Leather Development Corporation, which was owned and controlled by the State Government in the department of Industry and

Commerce for the purpose of pension and other service benefits as allowed to other similarly situated including to the above mentioned petitions.
