This is a criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, in which primarily, two prayers have been made. The first prayer made is with respect to taking action on the complaint dated 19.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) made to the police against the private respondents which includes respondent No.8-Simran, who is daughter-in-law of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the above-said complaint has been looked into and the same has been sent to the record room.

Insofar as the first prayer is concerned, it would be open to the petitioner to seek appropriate remedy regarding the same, in accordance with law.

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The second prayer made in the present petition is with respect to the fact that respondent No.8 has given a complaint to the police station against the petitioner and the petitioner is being called to the police station and as yet, there is no FIR registered against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is an old lady of 53 years and he would be satisfied in case the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to serve a written notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C., in case the petitioner is required in the complaint filed by respondent No.8.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the official respondents have been following the procedure, in accordance with law and would keep following the same in future also.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to issue notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C., in case the petitioner is required in the complaint filed by respondent No.8.
