The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present writ petition is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents to decide the representation dated 20.1.2015 (Annexure P-1) and for revival of the allotment letter of Flat No. 6306-B, Sector 56, Chandigarh.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he will be satisfied in case the representation dated 20.1.2015 (Annexure P-1) for revival of the allotment letter is decided expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that they have no objection in case the prayer of the petitioner is accepted.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Secretary, Chandigarh Housing Board, Sector 9, U.T. Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation dated 20.1.2015 (Annexure P-1) within 12 weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of 12 weeks thereafter, in accordance with law. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
