The application is allowed, as prayed for.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner, who is a widow lady, is being defrauded by her own brother in respect of the property left behind by their father. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was forced to pay a sum of more than Rs.10 lacs to respondent No.4 on the pretext of transferring his share in the name of the petitioner but respondent No.4 is still harassing the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the grievance before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh vide representation dated 08.08.2021 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the said authority and the petitioner will be satisfied, in

case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. Akashdeep Singh, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for U.T. Chandigarh, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and raises no objection for deciding the representation dated 08.08.2021 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 08.08.2021 (Annexure P-7), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 08.08.2021 (Annexure P-7) within a period of six weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It will be appreciated that while deciding the representation, due opportunity of representation is given to respondent No.4, with whom the petitioner is stated to have dispute.
