Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.315 dated 25.06.2021 under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and has relied upon the compromise (Annexure P-2) as well as affidavit of the complainant dated 08.12.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the complainant has filed Power of Attorney and acknowledged that there is a compromise between the parties.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 21.12.2021 in the Court today.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 27.06.2021 and the matter has been settled between the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
