By way of filing the present civil writ petition, petitioner Dr. Anurag Brijmohan Gupta prays for issuance of direction to respondents to release the arrears accrued to him for the period 01.01.2016 till September, 2017, as per guidelines of 7th Pay Commission with interest. In the alternative, a prayer has been made to direct the respondents, especially respondent No.3, to decide and take appropriate action on the representation dated 16.08.2019(Annexure P-5) stated to have been submitted by him, which according to him, has not evoked any response.

Under the circumstances, keeping in view the nature of the dispute, in order to afford an opportunity to respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner and then to take remedial action, if any, so as to avoid unnecessary litigation, the writ petition is disposed of directing respondent No.3 to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner, as per law, instructions, guidelines on the subject and if it is found that some action is warranted in the matter, including payment of arrears, if found due with interest @ 6% on belated payment, then needful will be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Such respondent is required to pass a detailed speaking order while disposing of the representation. It is clarified that in case after disposal of the representation, the petitioner still feels dis-satisfied he may approach to this Court again in accordance with law.
