The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the work charge service of the petitioner w.e.f. 05.03.1974 to 08.09.1979 followed by regular service w.e.f. 09.09.1979 towards pensionary benefits viz pension, gratuity, G.P. Fund and leave encashment etc and to release the aforesaid revised retiral benefits after counting his work charge service and its consequent arrears thereof along with interest thereon @ 12% per annum.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions respondents to consider the legal notice dated 08.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
