Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 57 dated 14.07.2020 registered under Section 406 and 498-A IPC, at Police Station Women, District Chandigarh.

Vide order dated 23.09.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 23.09.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench and the order dated 24.11.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satish Kumar, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required

for any further investigation. He further submits that the matter has been settled between the complainant and Sahil-son of the petitioners.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
