Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to the respondents to extend the parole period of the petitioner with effect from 19.08.2021 for a period of eight weeks' on account of fracture in left femur, suffered by the petitioner for which he was operated upon on 07.08.2021 and is bedridden.

By referring to the Certificate issued by Dr. Parveen Garg, M.S. (Ortho.), Annexure P-2, counsel for the petitioner submits that after his operation, the petitioner has been advised bed rest for a period of three months. He has requested that the parole period, which expired on 19.08.2021, be extended for a period of eight weeks'.

On asking of the Court, State counsel has sought instructions from ASI Mandeep Singh and filed an affidavit of the Superintendent Central Jail, Patiala, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. As per his verbal instructions, Certificate, Annexure P-2, has been verified and found to be factually correct.

Heard.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has been operated upon on account of a fracture and has been advised bed rest, his period of parole is ordered to be extended for a period of eight weeks' from 19.08.2021.

Petition is disposed of.
