This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.287 dated 18.08.2020, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420 and 506 IPC 1860, registered at Police Station, Tararori, District Karnal. The petitioner apprehended her arrest at the hands of police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 29.09.2020, whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. He contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted herself before the police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the police authorities during the

investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. Learned counsel further states that a sum of Rs.67,000/- has been paid to the complainant by way of draft bearing No.131496 dated 22.02.2021 in her favour. Photocopy of the draft is taken on record.

This fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the complainant.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Sukhvinder Singh, does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. He, on instructions, further states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 29.09.2020 is made absolute.
