The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.312 dated 14.12.2020 registered under Sections 307, 336, 323, 341, 427, 506, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and 25/27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 25.08.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“....Counsel for the petitioners has argued that as per the version of the complainant Babandeep Singh @ Bhawandeep Singh and another injured person namely Amandeep Singh @ Amanpreet Singh, the co-accused Mani @ Mahesh Jindal along with Sira, Vicky, Om Parkash @ Soma, Johnny and Jassi @ Billa, have attacked them and caused injuries by using fire-arms.

Counsel for the petitioners has also submitted that the petitioners were not named in the FIR and their names surfaced later on and the matter has already been

compromised between the parties. It is further submitted that in pursuance to the compromise, one petition i.e. CRM-M No.21566 of 2021, has been filed praying for quashing of the aforesaid FIR on the basis of the compromise and in pursuance to the order dated 02.07.2021, both the aforesaid complainant and the injured witness have already recorded their statements before the trial Court.

Notice of motion....”

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 25.08.2021, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation. It is further submitted that in terms of the compromise, the statement of the parties have been recorded.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 25.08.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
