Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for stopping the practice of issuing the recovery notices and making recoveries from the salaries of drivers and conductors.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the recovery notices are being issued to the driver and conductors of Haryana Roadways in discriminatory manner by the General Managers, which is in violation of principles of natural justice. Learned counsel further submits that a legal notice dated 21.02.2021 to this effect has been served upon the respondents but to no avail. Hence, the present petition.

Heard.

The writ petition, filed by a union, ostensibly espousing the cause of its members, is dismissed with liberty to the members/employees of the petitioner-Union to take up their individual cause, in case of any grievance qua any recovery notice issued to any of them.
