The petitioner has been issued a show cause notice on the ground that he did not fulfill the eligibility criteria inasmuch as the educational certificates submitted were fake. The petitioner has filed a reply stating that the allegation is incorrect and that he is actually a graduate from a recognized university and there is no truth in the allegations.

The writ petition has been filed apprehending an adverse order being passed.

There is no material on record which may support this apprehension. Thus, the writ petition is premature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
