Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

**CRM-W No.1008 of 2021**

Since the detenue joined the company of the petitioner, this application is not pressed.

The application stands dismissed as not pressed.

**CRWP No.7977 of 2021**

Prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to get released detenue-Jaipreet Kaur, wife of the petitioner, stated to have been illegally detained by private respondents No.4 to 7, by appointing a Warrant Officer to search the house of respondents No.4 to 7 or any other place to recover the detenue.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the marriage of the petitioner with detenue was solemnized on 23.11.2020. On the pretext of performing a proper marriage, the sister of the detenue called her to her parental home where it is alleged that she has detained illegally.

This Court vide order dated 20.08.2021 appointed a Warrant

Officer to record the statement of the detenue.

In compliance to the order passed by this Court, the Warrant Officer along with SHO and SI Gurpreet Kaur went to the designated place along with the petitioner and his friend namely, Karan Kumar. The detenue-Jaipreet Kaur was found and informed regarding the purpose of visiting her as it was 11.15 PM. The detenue in affirmative stated that she has solemnized the marriage with Amit Singh-petitioner on 23.11.2020 and wishes to go along with him immediately. The statement of detenue-Jaipreet Kaur was recorded. The necessary entry was made on computer in Roz Namcha and thereafter detenue-Jaipreet Kaur, as per her desire was set free to join the company of petitioner i.e. Amit Singh. The report along with the statement of Jaipreet Kaur recorded by the SHO in the presence of SI Gurpreet Kaur on 20.08.2021 is taken on record as Mark 'X'.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied and does not want to press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
