By this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of 'mandamus' directing the respondents to release him on parole for 8 weeks, to meet his family members.

As per the reply filed on behalf of respondents no.1, 2 and 4, there are 13 criminal cases registered against the petitioner, in different states of the country, including the one in which he has been convicted for the commission of an offence punishable under the provisions of Section 302 of the IPC.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the only son of his parents and therefore would like to meet them, looking at the reasons for rejection of his application by the District Magistrate, Moga, copy Annexure R-2/T, (essentially on that very ground), I would see no reason to entertain this petition, which is consequently, dismissed.

Naturally, if the petitioners' parents desire to meet him, they would do so in the jail premises, in terms of the rules/regulations laid down in the Punjab Jail Manual.
