The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.22 dated 13.05.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station Women Amritsar, District Amritsar.

As per the report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, the parties have failed to arrive at an amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 12th July, 2019 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. It is the case of the petitioner that the FIR in question is the outcome of a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and his wife-respondent No.2.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmit Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 12th July, 2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC.
