The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.272, dated 05.08.2020, under Sections 307, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 302 IPC of 1860 added later on) registered at P.S. Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been declared innocent by the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Manjot Singh has also conceded that the petitioner has indeed been declared innocent by the investigating agency, therefore he is not required for any interrogation.
