Petitioner seeks writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement order dated 12.3.2020 (Annexure P-4) passed by Assistant Collector, 1st Grade-cum-Sub Divisional Officer (C), Indri under Section 7 of Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961.

During pendency of the petition, two reports have been filed regarding demarcation. At the outset, Mr. Balyan submits that there appears to be conflicting affidavits filed by two officers. It has, thus, been decided to get fresh report from a senior officer. He assures the Court that needful will be done as per law. In view of statement made by him, no further order need be passed.
