Case heard by video conference.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.61, dated 19.05.2017, having been registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 379-B/323/411 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the petitioner was admitted to bail under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. by this court (co-ordinate bench) on 25.09.2017, in CRM-M-34954-2017, vide the order Annexure P-2, he could not appear before the trial court on a single date, i.e. 10.02.2020, leading to his bail bonds being cancelled.

However, it is seen that petitioner has not even approached the learned Sessions Court under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. thereafter.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to approach the learned Sessions Court under the same provision, with that petition to be decided wholly on its own merits.
