The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Bhupinder Jit Singh, stated to be aged 45 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside impugned order dated 05.08.2020 (Annexure P-3), passed by respondent No.3, whereby, the petitioner has been transferred from Hoshiarpur to Jalandhar, along with the prayers as mentioned in the prayer clause of the writ petition.

Records of the case show that on 28.09.2020, notice of motion was issued.
