The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashing the action of respondents thereby denying pension to petitioner on account of rendering 23 years of service from 23.05.1992 to 14.09.2015 with further directions to respondents to consider the service rendered by petitioner from 13.05.1992 to 14.09.2015 for the purpose of pension alongwith consequential benefits alongwith

interest @ 18% per annum, for which, legal notice dated 10.08.2020 (Annexure P-7) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Let copy of paper book be supplied to her.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner's side the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider legal notice dated 10.08.2020 (Annexure P-7) as representation of petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
