Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.53 dated 13.02.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 342 IPC (Section 302 added later on), registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the evidence in this case was concluded in October, 2019. The petitioner has earlier filed CRM-M-16454-2020 for grant of bail to the petitioner. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 26.06.2020, which reads as under:

“ The case has been taken up by way of Video Conference as per instructions in view of COVID-19 pandemic.

Earlier, petitioner has filed CRM-M-53355-2019 for grant of bail. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 19.12.2019 with a request to the trial Court to make an endeavour to dispose of the case expeditiously, considering that prosecution evidence had already been concluded.

Today, learned counsel for parties are agreed that

all evidence has concluded and the case is listed for arguments.
In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a request to the trial Court to dispose of the case, fixed before it for 13.7.2020, within two months.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that now the case is listed before the trial Court for arguments on 11.10.2021.

Keeping in view the earlier orders as well, the present petition is disposed of and learned trial Court is requested to dispose of the case expeditiously preferably within a period of two months.
