Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.73 dated 05.06.2019, under Sections 406, 498-A, 323 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, Distt. Gurdaspur.

By virtue of the order dated 20.06.2019, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Bakshish Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the contentions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 20.06.2019 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
