The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the pension of petitioner regularly and continuously as in the month of August 2020, without any reason, the pension of petitioner has been stopped, for which, representation dated 15.07.2021 (Annexure P-5) has also been moved before the respondent authorities.

Record perused.

In the light of averments made in the petition, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider the representation dated 15.07.2021 (Annexure P-5) of petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
