The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to count the service rendered by the petitioner on the sanctioned Government post in Guru Gobind Singh Khalsa College, Sarhali, District Tarn Taran as Accounts Clerk for the purpose of qualifying service towards the pensionary benefits, for which,

legal notice dated 30.05.2021 (Annexure P-6) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Shireesh Gupta, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let copy of paper book be supplied to him.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner's side the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider legal notice dated 30.05.2021 (Annexure P-6) as representation of petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
