Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.172 dated 1.8.2020 registered under Sections 498-A IPC at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar.

By virtue of the order dated 29.9.2020, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harminder Singh, has endorsed the same and submitted that they are in a position to file the challan and the petitioner is no more required for further

investigation.

However, learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that recovery is yet to be effected.

In view of the above, the order dated 29.9.2020 is made absolute and the petition stands allowed.
