Main case

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the
Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the
respondents to allow petitioners to change their option for grant of revised pay
scales with effect from 01.11.2006 instead of their earlier option i.e. with effect
from 01.01.2006 in terms of the Punjab Civil Services (Revised Pay Scales) Rules,
2009

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case legal notice dated 26.03.2021 (P-21) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-21) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
