By this petition, the petitioner challenged the draft assessment which had been passed without issuing mandatory show cause notice to the petitioner and on the very date when the petition came up for hearing, the respondents went ahead and passed the main assessment also which is illegal precisely for the same reason viz. violation of the principle of natural justice.

In these circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to file fresh one challenging the provisional order as well as the final order.

Allowed as prayed for. Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with afore-said liberty.
