The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.108 dated 26.06.2021 under Sections 323, 354, 506, 341, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Dehlon District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has since joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 26.08.2021, which was passed in the following terms:

“Learned counsel submits that it is a case of false implication as there was a quarrel between the complainant and the petitioner and his family on account of car parking. He submits that after four days of the occurrence in question, the petitioner was assigned a role of physically assaulting the complainant. Learned counsel further submits that all the injuries attributed to the petitioner are blunt and simple injuries. It is also submitted that the co-accused of the petitioner has been granted the concession of bail vide order dated

02.08.2021 passed in CRM-M-30243-2021 (Annexure P-4). ”

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Jugraj Singh states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 26.08.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
