Main case

This is fourth petition for grant of bail pending trial in a crime case no. 29 dated 17.07.2018 registered under Sections 8, 15, 29, 60 and 61 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, Narcotic Control Bureau Zonal Unit, Sector 25, UT, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel representing the Narcotics Control Bureau, on instructions from IO Rajnish, has submitted that the prosecution has already examined its entire evidence except cross examination of the last witness. He submits that the trial court has now fixed the case for 02.11.2021.

As the trial of the case is at its fag end, therefore, this Court does not find it appropriate to consider the prayer for grant of bail at this stage. However, learned trial court is requested to make a sincere endeavour for expeditious disposal of the case.
