Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.28 dated 09.06.2021 under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Jaurkian, District Mansa; earlier one i.e. CRM-M-29742-2021 was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 29.07.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that new ground for filing this second petition is that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the petitioner as well as other accused have paid the amount to victim Sapandeep Singh. Learned counsel relies upon the order dated 25.08.2021 passed in CRM-M-33603-2021, vide which co-accused Ramneet

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Singh has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail, by passing the following order: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR registered at the instance of Sapandeep Singh, he has paid certain amounts to the petitioner for procuring a government job.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably settled. He has referred to an order dated 20.08.2021 passed by the Sub Division Judicial Magistrate, Sardulgarh, wherein after verifying that there is a compromise between the parties, co-accused Raman Kumar was granted the concession of regular bail....”

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant have not disputed the aforesaid factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted the concession of anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

It will be open for the Investigating Officer to issue an advance notice in writing to the petitioner, if he is required for the investigation.
