This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C., in case FIR No.213 dated 22.03.2021, under Sections 148, 149, 186, 223, 225, 332, 353, 379-B & 506 of the IPC (Sections 201, 427 & 34 of the IPC added and Sections 148, 149 & 223 deleted later on), registered at Police Station Rai, District Sonipat.

[2]. The petitioner has remained in detention in the present case for nearly 8 months, since 31.03.2021.

[3]. After completion of the investigation, Challan against the petitioner has already been submitted. Although, Charges have been framed, but trial is yet to commence, as not even the first witness from the prosecution side has been examined. As such further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not called for.

[4]. For the aforesaid reasons, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention

undergone by the petitioner, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
