Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0015 dated 24.07.2021 registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC, 1860 at Police Station GRP Amritsar, District Amritsar.

On 26.08.2021 this Hon'ble Court while asking the petitioner to join investigation passed the following order:-

*“Relies upon order dated 20.08.2021
(Annexure P-3).*

Notice of motion for 16.12.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The

petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-33979-2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 26.08.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation/custodial interrogation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 26.08.2021 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
