Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.136 dated 23.08.2019, registered under Sections 307, 323, 341, 212, 506, 120-B, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been involved in the present case and that as co-accused, namely, Amit Sharma, has been granted the concession of bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 17.08.2020, the petitioner may also be granted such concession on the ground of parity. It is further submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 25.08.2019.

Per contra, while opposing the prayer for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the

complainant, submits that the petitioner had inflicted three fire-arm injuries on the person of the complainant and that two bullets are still in the body of the complainant, as the same could not be removed owing to the risk involved in the surgery. Even in the disclosure statement, the petitioner had admitted the factum of inflicting the firm-arm injuries on the person of the complainant.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

As notice above, the petitioner had inflicted three firm-arm injuries on the person of the complainant. The allegations against the petitioner are serious and grave in nature. Therefore, keeping in view the gravity and seriousness of the offence, no case is made out to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
